Snow Parking Ban

Elwood, Illinois – The Village of Elwood would like to remind residents the snow parking ban is in effect until such time as all snow removal operations are completed. Please do not park any vehicle on the street during the snow event or until your street has been plowed. Police are issuing citations and your vehicle may be towed.

Village ordinance No.919 Parking Prohibited 2 Inches Snowfall \$50 fine.

PARKING PROHIBITED It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle or, if parked, to allow a motor vehicle to remain parked or standing in any highway, street or alley within the Village during or after a snowfall in which there is an accumulation of two (2) inches or more. The prohibition shall remain in effect until such time as the street or alley has been plowed or the snow has been removed therefrom. A Village street shall not be deemed to have been plowed until the lane of traffic nearest the curb has been cleared or the snow has been removed therefrom.

In addition, residents are reminded it's also against village ordinance to shovel or plow snow into the street.

Village ordinance No. 893 DEPOSTING SNOW, SOIL, DEBRIS AND THE LIKE.

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit any snow, soil, debris or other undesirable material from any sidewalk, driveway or parking lot or other premises onto any street, alley or sidewalk. It shall also be unlawful for any person to sweep or deposit any snow, soil, debris or other undesirable material from any sidewalk or building onto any public parkway.
