

ORDINANCE 889

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING POLICIES FOR THE PUBLIC OR PRIVATE, NON-COMMERICAL USE OF THE COMMUNITY ROOM LOCATED WITHIN THE ELWOOD MUNICIPAL CENTER FOR THE VILLAGE OF ELWOOD, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS

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WHEREAS, the Village of Elwood (sometimes hereinafter "Elwood" or the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Village President and Board of Trustees ("Corporate Authorities"), among other things, possess the responsibility to set policy for the proper management and control of all municipal property, including public lands and municipal buildings for the benefit of its constituents; and

WHEREAS, the construction of the Elwood Municipal Center was completed on or about October 1, 2007, and thereafter the building was opened for use, including the Community Room contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have devised guidelines for the public or private, non-commercial use of the Community Room within the Elwood Municipal Center, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herewith as Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ACTING VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELWOOD, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AND HOME RULE AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION That the preambles to this Ordinance be, and the same hereby are incorporated by this reference as if set out in full at this place.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION The Village of Elwood hereby adopts the Community Use Policy and Agreement, Community Room, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to achieve the objectives of proper and lawful management and control of that portion of the Elwood Municipal Center.

SECTION 3. REPEALER All ordinances or resolutions of the Village of Elwood inconsistent herewith, to the extent of such inconsistency and no further, are hereby repealed upon the effective date hereof.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY Should any section, subsection or other provision of this Ordinance for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part not declared invalid.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance, by publication in pamphlet form for general distribution in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


