**ORDINANCE NO. 1118**

**AN ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO  
PERMITTING DOGS IN A CERTAIN PUBLIC PARK**

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to allow dogs in certain areas of Lloyd Erickson Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELWOOD, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS STATUTORY, HOME-RULE AND OTHER AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.           AMENDMENT**

That 91.05 is hereby included to include the following as 91.05(F):

91.05(F)           Pet Walk Designation

That portion of Lloyd Erickson Park north of the Children's Garden, south of Diagonal Road and west of Chicago Road is hereby designated as a "Dog Pet Walk Way" as provided in (D) above. Dogs will be permitted within this Pet Walk Way provided that they are leashed and the dog owner has received a pet park lanyard from the Village. This lanyard will be issued upon payment of a twenty-dollar (\$20.00) fee, completion of an application and proof of a current rabies vaccination. The lanyard shall be prominently displayed by the owner or custodian of the dog whenever in the Pet Walk Way.

**SECTION 2.           SEVERABILITY**

In the event any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be held to be unconstitutional, unenforceable or void, the same shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions or sections of this ordinance.

**SECTION 3. REPEALER**

All ordinances or parts thereof which conflict with any term, condition, provision or section of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.
